

Lael Har is a contemporary landscape painter, art mentor, and founder of Lael Gallery & Studios in Boulder, Colorado. Inspired by the natural world, she creates vibrant acrylic and mixed media paintings that capture the energy, atmosphere, and emotional resonance of the subjects she encounters.

Her artistic journey began in childhood, where her talent quickly emerged. During high school, she was commissioned to paint interior and theatrical murals. After earning a Bachelor of Fine Arts (BFA), she worked in graphic design before returning to her first love - painting full time.

Her transition into the fine art world was influenced by her mentor, Dvora Kanegis, and years of dedicated study in acrylic painting and the business of art. In 2009, Lael took ownership of what is now Lael Gallery & Studios in North Boulder, transforming it into a creative community where artists gather to learn, grow, and create together.

Since 2005, Lael has exhibited her work in open studios, galleries, museums, art festivals, and private collections. Her paintings are collected throughout the United States, and her work has been featured by Fox News, CBS Colorado, ABC, The Washington Post, The

Daily Camera, Voyage Denver, and Colorado Homes & Lifestyles.

Teaching is as much a part of Lael's creative life as painting. She has guided hundreds of artists in discovering their own creative voice through workshops, retreats, and mentoring. Her approach encourages curiosity helping students paint with confidence, intuition, and joy.

Working primarily in acrylics with large brushes, palette knives, and expressive mark-making, Lael has created over 1,000 original paintings. Her largest public work, an 8 × 24-foot memorial mural, is permanently displayed at the Table Mesa King Soopers in Boulder.
